As part of the Hawai'i CARES Network, 211 now offers Care Coordinators for Substance Use Disorders (SUD). Our helpline acts as a comprehensive community information hub, staffed by knowledgeable local experts dedicated to connecting individuals with essential resources.



Nonprofit agencies collaborate with AUW and stakeholders to tackle financial instability for working households unable to cover basic expenses. ALICE Households, ineligible for typical aid, remain vulnerable and underserved. AUW's ALICE Research and Initiative are pivotal in shaping our future. (80114)
