






ALICE in Hawai'i:

Importance of Credit Score

The Effect of the COVID-19 Pandemic

29%	Reduction of hours / wages	16%
41%	Member of the household getting COVID-19	16%
21%	Serious health condition, physical disability, or medical issue other than COVID-19	14%
19%	Difficulty providing enough food for the household	12%
13%	Getting health care or medication needed to due to cost	10%
17%	Challenges related to education and/or remote learning	8%
12%	Challenges related to childcare	7%
17%	Loss of job	6%
